- This meeting forms a part of the celebrations of the jubilee year for the *fiftieth anniversary* of the arrival of the Camillians in Burkina Faso (celebration/event envisaged for 16 October 2016, with an invitation to take part extended to all those of our religious brothers who have made possible the presence of the Camillians in Burkina Faso).
- The jubilee spirit will also be the context to celebrate together the *Canonical Erection of the Camillian New Province of Burkina Faso* (celebration/event envisaged for <u>13 October 2016</u>).
- Our religious brothers of Burkina Faso have already begun to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Mercy, and at a specific level the arrival of the first Camillians fifty years ago, with a whole series of spiritual, formation, vocational and liturgical initiatives gathered together beneath a line from the gospels (Lk 5:4): 'Witnesses to Mercy. Put Out into Deep Water (Duc in Altum)'. This will also be a spiritual stimulus that will accompany our meeting!

major Superiors belong; cooperation at the level of ministry and formation; the European Provinces

are asked to focus on the prospects for their future existence (fusion, union, amalgamation,

elimination, move to being a Delegation of...) and to keep these reflections so as to develop them at

their respective Provincial Chapters as well; and the 'question of the diaspora of religious in different

Provinces'.
